Directions

1. If by Land:
Take US 101 to the Tiburon Blvd. exit. Head East on Tiburon Blvd. for approximately 4 miles. At the light, go right on Beach Road. Beach Road bends to the right and the Club is .3 miles on the left side.
2. If by Sea
SFYC is located on Raccoon Strait across from Angel Island. See the chart below for more information. Do not cut the corner to the South/West as it is shallow. Enter through marked channel in front of Corinthian Yacht Club to the East. [Visiting Yachtsman](#) from affiliated clubs are welcome.

Facilities:

[Berthing facilities](#) for visitors are located directly in front of the Clubhouse deck. Visitors may not enter any slip or tie up anywhere else in the harbor without first obtaining permission from either the Harbormaster, the Port Captain, the General Manager or other designated officer. All visiting yachts must fly their burgee. Charges for the use of the Club Dock are as set forth in the Club Dock Rules, which are included below.

Charges for use of the Club Dock by non-members are as follows: Day Use: No charge for the first two hours; thereafter the overnight fee is charged.

Overnight Use: \$1.00 per linear foot per night

Heads are available inside the Clubhouse and heads and showers are available in a separate building in the parking lot. These facilities are locked from 6pm to 8am. An entry card may be obtained from the Bartender for use during your stay.

Potable water is only available on the two main piers of the Club Dock. Boats which may be assigned to berths should be aware that water drawn there is not potable

In most cases, dress is casual and informal. Shirts and footwear must be worn at all times when in the Clubhouse. Alcoholic beverages may not be brought onto or removed from the Club premises at any time. Ice is available on request from the bartender at \$1.00 per bag.

The SFYC Harbor is up and running on a new wireless service! You can access this from your boat at anytime now. For the time being, this is a complimentary service which does not need a Login Name and Password.

Activities Schedule:

Saturday: Arrive after 11:00 a.m. If you need to arrive earlier please contact Bill or Larry.

Dinner at 7:00 p.m. Wild Salmon or Prime Rib: \$37.50 per person (includes one bottle of white wine and one bottle of red wine per table of eight). Children's menu is available.

Sunday: Brunch from 8:30 to 11:00 a.m. Cost is \$12.95 per person. Children's menu is available.
