Overview: The Golden Gate Yacht Club has come a long way since its founding in 1939, when members built a clubhouse on a barge in the San Francisco Marina. After the 1989 Loma Prieta Quake severely damaged the club, members pulled together and rebuilt it into the showcase facility that now exists.

Slip Assignments: Due to shallow water at the guest dock we will be limited to 12 boats. There will be shore power available for 5 boats. We will raft-up the other boats. There might be 2 additional slips available for our use. These slips are reserved until 5pm for club member use. If the slips are not reserved we have made arrangements with the club for their use.

Activities Schedule: Saturday night dinner will be a Potluck in the Yacht Club. Cocktails and Hors d'oeuvres will be at 5:00pm, dinner at 6:00pm. The club will open for breakfast at 11:00am, for those that are interested. For an earlier breakfast how about a potluck, Barb promises to get things started with her famous sausage.

Notes on Facilities: Golden Gate Yacht Club is located at One Yacht Road in the San Francisco Marina's West Yacht Basin, approximately 1.8 nautical miles east of the Golden Gate Bridge. The end of the marina breakwater is located at Latitude - 37° 48.532' N, Longitude - 122° 26.394' W. The Clubhouse is the first gray building to starboard after you enter the harbor.
