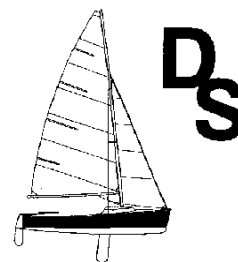

Saturday, September 22 and Sunday, September 23, 2007

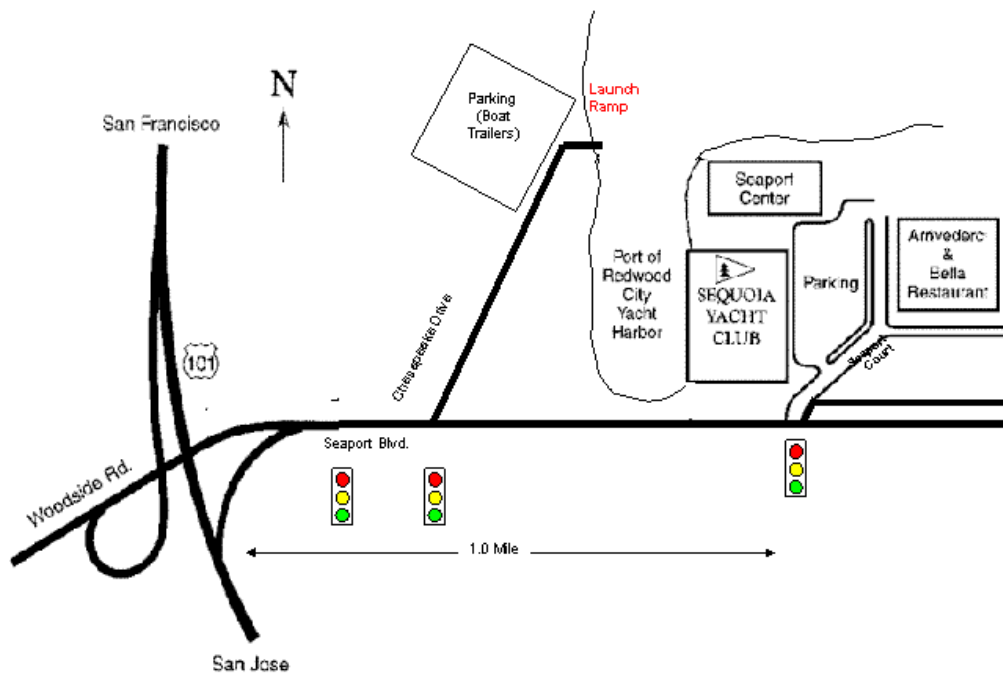
Rules: The race will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the individual class rules and the Sailing Instructions (available at the skippers meeting).

Eligibility and Entry: This regatta is open to all Day Sailer class boats. Eligible yachts may enter by filing a completed entry form, with fees prior to the close of registration at 11:00 AM Saturday, September 15, 2007. (The entry fee is \$25.00 per boat. There is a \$5.00 discount for US Sailing members. Make checks out to Charlie Gray.)

Location: Port of Redwood City turning basins.

Take the Seaport Blvd. exit from the Bayshore Freeway (Highway 101). Turn left on Chesapeake Drive. Proceed to the municipal ramp at the end of Chesapeake Drive

Launch at the municipal ramp on Chesapeake Drive (There is a \$5.00 launch fee)

Mooring boats overnight: Boats may be left rigged overnight Saturday September 22nd at the guest dock of Sequoia Yacht Club

Equipment: Yachts shall be equipped with Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices for both the skipper and the crew.

Scoring: The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 will apply. The worst score will be discarded if five or more races are sailed.

Prizes: Awards will be presented to top three finishers in the A fleet, and top finisher in the B fleet for the two combined racing days, at the Sequoia YC clubhouse at the conclusion of racing
