STATEMENTS OF POLICY**

**REGARDING DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS**

As adopted by the Board of Directors, February 7, 1996

Pursuant to Article IV, Section 2, of the Constitution and Bylaws of Sequoia Yacht Club regarding "Payment of Dues and Bills," the names of members whose accounts are in arrears (60 days past due) and have been notified may be posted at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

**REGARDING MONETARY REIMBURSEMENT**

As adopted by the Board of Directors, June 2, 1993

Requests from members for monetary reimbursement of expenditures pertaining to Club business must be made within ninety (90) days of the expenditure. Bills and receipts must be included with the request, along with an explanation of the expenditure. Failure to request reimbursement within 90 days could result in non-payment.

**REGARDING NEW MEMBER SPONSORSHIP**

As adopted by the Board of Directors, March 6, 1996

A Senior member who sponsors a new member shall be responsible for the well being of that new member for the first year of membership. This responsibility shall include:

- Specific, individual invitations to participate in Club activities.
- Social support at Club activities.
- Encouraging and promoting involvement on Club committees.
- Encouraging and promoting involvement in the planning and executing of Club activities.

**REGARDING CLUB BURGEE EXCHANGES**

As adopted by the Board of Directors, February 4, 1987

The practice of exchanging burgees with other yacht clubs offering reciprocal privileges to our own members shall be encouraged. When a burgee exchange situation occurs, such as when a SYC member travels to another yacht club or when a fellow yachtsman from another club is visiting SYC, a flag officer may take a burgee from stock to be exchanged with the other club. The cost of this burgee shall be born by SYC, and accounted for appropriately. When this type of exchange is appropriate shall be left to the judgment of the flag officer in charge. Care should be taken not to duplicate burgees already displayed by SYC.

**REGARDING "COMPS"**

As adopted by the Board of Directors, March 1, 2000

Resolved that Sequoia Yacht Club, as a "volunteer" club, should limit the use of complimentary attendees (comps) at social functions. It is the current policy of the Board of Directors that, where necessary or appropriate, the Commodore or Vice Commodore may authorize the use of comps. Further, it is suggested that such comps be made available first to members of Sequoia Yacht Club and then, only if necessary, are they to be used with non-members of the Club.
