



2019 Single/Double-Handed Series Notice of Race

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. In accordance with the purpose of these races, autopilot and/or wind-powered self-steering gear are allowed. This modifies RRS 52.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all sailboats with a valid Northern California PHRF (NCPHRF) certificate issued by the Yacht Racing Association of San Francisco Bay.
- 2.2. All boats shall have a crew of one or two named persons, one of whom shall be at least 18 years of age.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by registering on jibset.net
- 2.4. All boats shall have a signed Skipper Entry Form for the 2018-2019 racing season on file with the club. Forms are available at the club office and on jibset.net.
- 2.5. All crew shall have a signed Crew Registration Form for the 2018-2019 racing season on file with the club. Forms are available at the club office and on jibset.net.
- 2.6. Deadline to enter is 1000 on September 14, 2019

3. SCHEDULE

- 3.1. The regatta will consist of 5 races
- 3.2. Dates of racing:
 - 3.2.1. February 23, 2019
 - 3.2.2. March 9, 2019
 - 3.2.3. April 6, 2019
 - 3.2.4. August 17, 2019
 - 3.2.5. September 14, 2019
- 3.3. The competitor's meeting will be held at 1030 the day of each race at the club.

4. MEASUREMENT

- 4.1. Each sailboat shall produce a valid Northern California PHRF certificate or be of a recognized one design class with a PHRF rating on file with the Yacht Racing Association of San Francisco Bay.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The sailing instructions will be available after 5pm on February 16, 2019 on jibset.net and on the race board at the club.

6. VENUE

6.1. The Race Committee intends to select courses in the South San Francisco Bay between the San Mateo-Hayward Bridge and the entrance to Redwood Creek, in the area indicated shown in the attached chart.

7. SCORING

7.1. Three races are required to be completed to constitute a series

7.1.1. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

7.1.2. When from four to five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

8. PRIZES

8.1. Series awards will be awarded at the annual Racers Ribs Dinner at the end of the season.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

9.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
